

LAOH Division 7 Scholarship Guidelines for 2022

The applicant must be a son/daughter/spouse/grandchild of an LAOH Division7 member for a minimum of two (2) years, in good standing, and that has taken their Degree and/or Division 7 Junior member

The applicant must complete the attached Application and submit it with all required documents stated on said Application and postmarked by April 15 to LAOH Division 7, Scholarship Committee, PO Box 774, East Islip, NY 11730:

- 1. Provide a personal statement of not more than 500 words describing your accomplishments, activities and goals.
- 2. A photocopy of member paid dues card
- 3. Official High School Transcript
- 4. A copy of acceptance letter from accredited school

The applicant cannot be related to a Scholarship Committee member.

The applicant can apply only once for this scholarship.

The scholarship of \$1,500 will be issued half upon award and the balance after first semester is completed and an official letter from the accredited school is submitted to the Committee.
