May 4th, at 8:00 pm. A Shamrock Degree will be performed at that meeting. Please keep our motto of Friendship, Unity and Christian Charity alive.

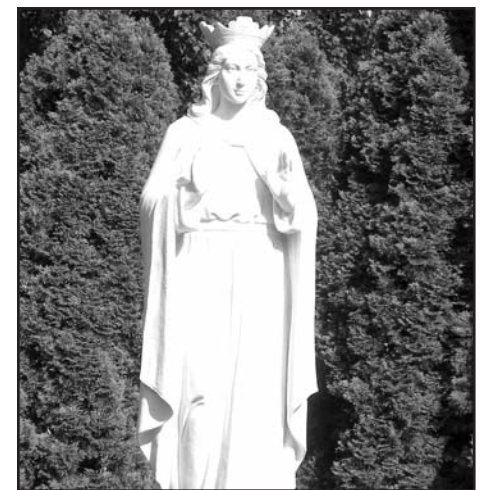

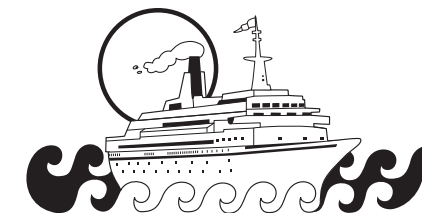

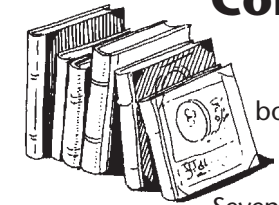
