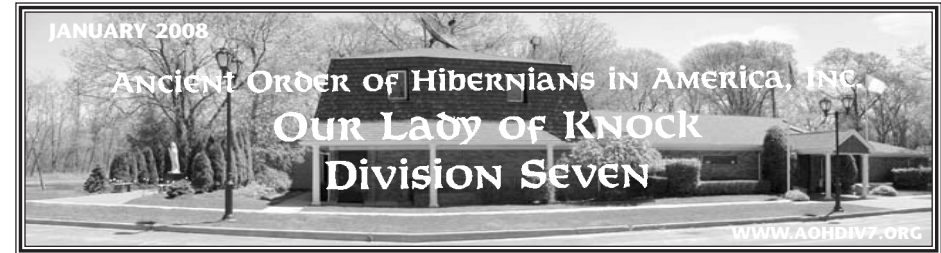

Calling Post

Division 7 has a process for sending out announcements that are of importance and cannot wait until a regularly scheduled meeting.
