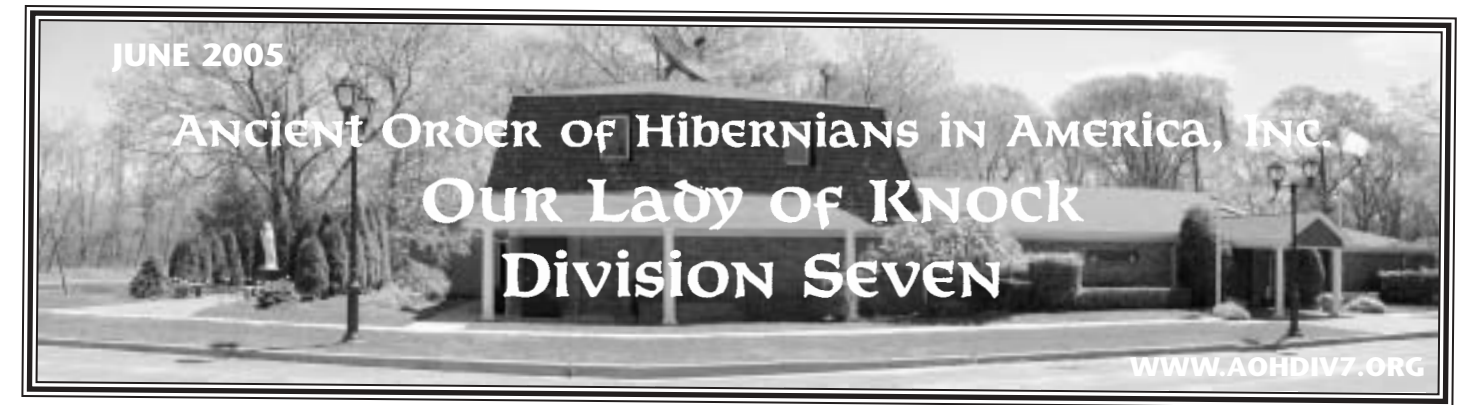

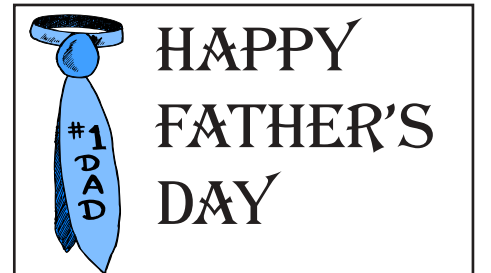

Learn To Recognize A Stroke and Act Quickly

Sudden numbness or weakness of the face, arm or leg, especially on one side of the body

Sudden confusion, trouble speaking or understanding

Sudden trouble seeing in one or both eyes

Sudden trouble walking, dizziness, loss of balance or coordination

Sudden, severe headache with no known cause

Call 9-1-1 immediately if you experience symptoms!

Time lost is brain lost!

A bystander can recognize a stroke by asking three simple questions:

Remember the 3 steps! Read and Learn!

- Ask the person to SMILE.
- Ask person to RAISE BOTH ARMS.

• Ask the person to SPEAK A SIMPLE SENTENCE.

Smile - Normal: both sides of the face moves equally, Abnormal: one sided facial droop

Raise arms - Normal: both arms move equally or not at all, Abnormal: one arm drifts compared to the other

Repeat a simple sentence i.e.: The quick brown fox jumped over the lazy brown dog. Simple, yet complex, enough sentence. Normal: Patient uses correct words without slurring. Abnormal: Slurred or inappropriate words, mute or does not comprehend.

If they have trouble with any of these tasks, call 9-1-1 immediately and describe the symptoms to the dispatcher.

After discovering that a group of non-medical volunteers could identify facial weakness, arm weakness and speech problems, researchers urged the general public to learn the three questions.

Widespread use of this test could result in prompt diagnosis and treatment of the stroke and prevent brain damage.


